

Please note:

Currently, the majority of available information on deep injection wells in Ohio cover **Class I** injection wells.

Oil and Gas production requires that **Class II** injection wells are used for waste disposal.

As of May 2011, ODNR sees deep well injection as more promising than other types of disposal such as “waste water treatment” for frack fluids.

Ohio currently has over 170 deep injection wells. Ohio currently accepts “frack water” from neighboring states that cannot support deep injection wells due to geology.
